Resolution Regarding Reciprocal Refund Offset

WHEREAS, the 105th Congress passed legislation authorizing the States to participate in the federal refund offset program beginning January 2000; and

WHEREAS, in the early months of the program, seven States have collected more than \$10 million in delinquent state tax debts through this program; and

WHEREAS, a majority of States are expected to participate in this program within the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, Financial Management Services, a branch of the United States Treasury, has authority over all federal offsets; and

WHEREAS, FMS has worked closely and with the highest degree of professionalism with the States to implement the reciprocal refund offset program; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Multistate Tax Commission thank FMS for its diligent work in implementing this important program; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Multistate Tax Commission encourage the States to consider the added value to their compliance efforts of participating in this program.
