Subject: Comments on Definitions

I suggest the following changes to the definitions set forth in the 2/22/99 draft:

1. I would shorten the term "Business entity" to "Entity" and the term "Business segment" to "Segment."
2. I would change the definition of "Business segment" to read: "'Segment' means a subdivision of an entity consisting of any grouping of business activities, functions, or transactions of the entity." I think this merely clarifies the intended meaning (at least as I understood it) in the draft.
3. In the definition of "Enterprise," I would change the words "unitary businesses being conducted within this State" to "unitary business or unitary businesses being conducted by the entity or entities."
4. In paragraph 2 of the presumptions (vertically related steps), I would change the word "enterprise" to "business" since I do not believe the word "enterprise" is being used here in the same context as it is defined.
