Subject: Training Program Report

Since January 1, the MTC has delivered the following courses:

February 5-8, 2007 Corporate Income Tax in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for 43 students,
with 33 students taking the audit portion of the course (Part 2).
April 23-27 Non-Statistical Sampling in New Orleans, Louisiana for 24 students
April 24-25 Nexus School in Denver, Colorado for 46 students

The following training events are scheduled at this time:

May 7-11 Computer Assisted Audit, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma
(This course is full)
June 5-6 Nexus School in Hartford, Connecticut
September 23-27 Audit and Computer Technology Workshop in Nashville, Tennessee
(cosponsored with FTA)

Plans for 2007/08

For the 2007/08 fiscal year, we anticipate course offerings similar to that provided in 2006/07. Tuition increases are expected for all courses—at an average of 23.5% for the anticipated course schedule—to more fully reflect the cost of providing courses, including the support provided by training management. The surcharge for other than compact and sovereignty member states is expected to be 25% for Associate Member States that participate in the Audit or Nexus Program (this is currently 20%), and 40% for all other states (this is currently 30% for Associate Member states that do not participate in the Audit or Nexus Program, and 40% for all other states).
