## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: Is Multistate Tax Commission (MTC) training open to the following:**

**Local government personnel?**

**A:** We include local government personnel in MTC courses. For example, many local government sales tax auditors have taken MTC sampling courses.

**All state government personnel?**

**A:** Yes, we welcome legislative and attorney general staff members who deal with tax matters in their work, in addition to our core audience from state revenue agencies.

**Private sector tax practitioners, advisors or consultants?**

**A:** Most sessions of Statistical Sampling for Sales and Use Tax Audits are open to private sector participants. Please check “Scheduled Training Events” for current information on sessions of this course.

**Q: What are the advantages of hosting an MTC training course?**

**A:** The host state saves substantial travel costs and time relative to attendance at an out-of-state course. In addition, the host state receives a \$3000 credit against tuition for its students.
