The status of Uniformity projects is summarized below:

Project/Work Groups		
Finnigan-Combined Filing Work Group		
Chair and Staff	Phil Skinner, Idaho; Bruce Fort and Helen Hecht, MTC Staff	
Scope of Project	This work group was tasked with creating an alternative combined filing model statute following the "Finnigan" approach. (The commission's existing model follows the "Joyce" approach).	
Status	Early in 2020, the work group completed its work and recommended a proposed draft to the Uniformity Committee, which approved that draft and recommended it to the Executive Committee in April. This committee approved the draft for public hearing. A public hearing was held on June 9, 2020 and the hearing officer, Bruce Fort, will present his report in a separate item on the committee's agenda.

Scope of Project	This work group was tasked with updating the Commission's Statement of Information Concerning Practices of Multistate Tax Commission and Sig- natory States under Public Law 86-272.	
Status	The work group completed its work and recommended proposed revisions to the Uniformity Committee, which approved them and recommended them to the Executive Committee in April. That committee approved the revisions for a public hearing that will be held August 5, 2020. Robert De- siderio has agreed to act as hearing officer. We expect the report of the hearing officer to be available at the Executive Committee's next meeting.	

Wayfair and Marketplace Implementation Work Group

Scope of Project	This work group is focusing on the issues that states are seeing in imple- menting the <i>Wayfair</i> decision, and especially on the collection and reporting requirements for marketplaces.	
Status	The work group has produced a white paper that is continuously updated, tracking what states are doing in response to various issues. The work group is currently on hold, pending a decision by Uniformity Committee to take up additional matters.
