


Q5: What is your training role?


Q6: Have you or your staff participated in any MTC training sessions in the last 3 years?




Q9: Would you want to attend /recommend your staff attend MTC training in the future?




Q11: What topics are important for you and your colleagues for possible MTC training?


Q12: What format(s) would be most helpful for the MTC to use to provide training to you or your staff?





Q16: How many of each of the following groups might you expect to attend MTC training in calendar year 2021?



Q17: Please indicate if there are certain months of the year you would most likely utilize MTC training.








Q21: Would you consider paying a one-time overall fee – similar to a subscription fee -- to access multiple live webinars?
