The committee directed the formation of this work group at its meeting in November 2019 in order to come up with a more explicit process for how the committee selects new projects to work on. This action followed on recommendations from a strategic planning task force that looked into the issue of how more successful projects might be selected.

The work group had its first call March 25, 2020 and a second call on April 1, 2020. Work group discussions have focused on the recommendations of the strategic planning task force that studied the reasons why states may or may not adopt uniformity recommendations. The work group has also had discussions of the uniformity process generally, including the public participation policy, and has decided to begin by looking at how other, similar organizations, particularly the Uniform Law Commission (ULC), select new projects. At the April 1, 2020 meeting, the work group asked commission staff to draft a process which might include a standing subcommittee to implement that process.
