Since December 2010, the Commission has presented four courses and we have tentatively scheduled three courses for late summer and fall 2011. In addition, we have renewed our certification with the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) as a CPE sponsor.

## **Courses Offered since December 2010**

The MTC has provided the following training courses since the Executive Committee teleconference meeting in December 2010:

#### Corporate Income Tax

March 14-16, 2011 in Boston, Massachusetts for 102 students—95 from the Massachusetts Department of Revenue and 7 additional students from Idaho, Indiana and Vermont.

#### Statistical Sampling for Sales and Use Tax Audits

March 28-31, 2011 in Chicago, Illinois for 8 students—7 from the private sector and 1 student from North Dakota.

#### Nexus School

May 11-12, 2011 in Denver, Colorado for 52 students—35 from Colorado and 17 additional students from Alaska, Idaho, Louisiana, Minnesota, North Dakota, Washington and West Virginia.
