Since the July 31, 2014 meeting of the Executive Committee, the Commission has presented five courses—Computer Assisted Audit Techniques Using Excel, Corporate Income Tax, Statistical Sampling for Sales and Use Tax Audits and the two sessions of the Nexus School. Courses Offered since July 2014

The MTC has provided the following training courses since the Commission and Executive Committee meetings in July 2014:

Computer Assisted Audit Techniques Using Excel

September 25-26, 2014 in Washington DC for 36 students from the District of Columbia and the MTC.

Corporate Income Tax

October 20-23, 2014 in Burlington, Vermont for 51 students from the Vermont, Arizona, Connecticut, Nebraska, New Hampshire and South Carolina.

Statistical Sampling for Sales and Use Tax Audits
