Resolution 98-8

TaxExchange Electronic Communications Network

WHEREAS, TaxNet Governmental Communications Corporation (TGCC) has been formed to provide network and communication services to State tax agencies to facilitate communication among them and to assist in accomplishing their respective missions, and

WHEREAS, TGCC is organized to qualify as an instrumentality of the States within the meaning of Section 115 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and as a public charity exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Sections 501(c)(3) and 501(a)(3) of the Code, and

WHEREAS, TGCC has introduced Phase I of a new electronic service intended to facilitate communications between the Federation of Tax Administrators, the Multistate Tax Commission and their members, and which is accessible through the Internet under the name TaxExchange, and

WHEREAS, Phase I of TaxExchange has shown great value in providing significant and timely information on issues affecting the tax administration process, and

WHEREAS, Phase I TaxExchange services will be provided to State tax administrators at no additional cost;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that State tax administrators are urged to evaluate and consider the use of TaxExchange as a provider of tax-related informational services within and among State revenue agencies.

This Resolution expires on August 7, 2003.
