V AUDIT DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Les Koenig, MTC Audit Director issued a written report on the status of the Audit program. The MTC Audit Program completed 5 sales tax and 1 income tax audits for the first quarter of fiscal year end 6/07. In addition parts of 3 additional income tax and 1 sales tax audits have been completed and sent to the states which were completed.

Les also reported that he, Jeff Silver, and Cathy Felix were instructors for an income tax training class that was held in Oregon during October 2006.

Les also reported that two additional auditors were hired. Robert Schauer from Washington was hired as a Computer Audit Specialist effective December 4, 2006. Dave Nowak from Ohio Department of Revenue was hired as an Income Tax Auditor effective January 29, 2007.
