Jeremy Feigenbaum, Solicitor General
New Jersey Office of the Attorney General

Jeremy Feigenbaum is the New Jersey Solicitor General, a role he has held since July 2020. He helps coordinate the Attorney General's involvement in matters before the U.S. Supreme Court, federal circuit courts, and the New Jersey Supreme Court, and provides assistance to the Department in cases involving significant constitutional and appellate issues. In that role, he has argued three cases before the U.S. Supreme Court. Jeremy previously served as Counsel in the Office of the Attorney General. Before joining the Office of the Attorney General, he was an associate at Kirkland & Ellis in New York. He has also served as an adjunct professor at New York University School of Law. Jeremy clerked for Judge William Fletcher of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit and Justice Elena Kagan of the U.S. Supreme Court. He graduated from Brown University and Harvard Law School.

John Kerkhoff, Deputy Solicitor General
Ohio Office of the Solicitor General

John serves in the Office of the Solicitor General as a Deputy Solicitor General and as the Director of the Tenth Amendment Center. In his role, John monitors federal actions, orders, statutes, and regulations for potential overreach and advises the Solicitor General about potential actions to protect the interests of the State of Ohio. John works in both state and federal courts, including the U.S. Supreme Court, the U.S. Courts of Appeals, and the Ohio Supreme Court.

John previously practiced as a litigator at two law firms in Columbus. He clerked for Judge Joseph Hood on the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky and Judge Eugene Siler for the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. He has a B.S. from Ohio University and a J.D. from Vanderbilt University Law School.
